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## Effective from 1 August 2018

1. Grants, usually up to the maximum value of £100, are awarded by The Liversage Trust to residents in the city of Derby, who are in hardship, to help them obtain essential household items.
2. Applications and grants must go through a second party, usually an agency worker, such as a social worker, health visitor, housing officer or family support worker, who is responsible for the administration of the grant. We are unable to consider applications made directly by an individual claimant.
3. Applications where possible, should be completed using the Trust's digital application form. This is the preferred option as it will assist in processing the grant application more quickly. Where the software used for this form is not supported by an agent's IT network, then a word version of the form can be submitted. Any form which is incomplete, unsigned or not the current version will be returned.

To use the digital form - please follow this easy guide:

- a. Download the form and save it to your computer. You will only have to do this once.
  - b. Select the folder where you have saved the form and click to open the document.
  - c. Select 'Yes' to the security message.
  - d. Complete the form (you may consider, for ease of use, that you type the reason for the grant in Word and then copy to the form)
  - e. Go to File, Save As and rename the form as the applicant's name.
  - f. Please email the saved form to [grants@liversagetrust.org](mailto:grants@liversagetrust.org)
  - g. Once submitted, a confirmation email will be sent directly to you at the email address provided.
4. Only one Household Fund grant can be made by an applicant within a two-year period but, in exceptional circumstances, we may waive this rule. Any award made will be dependent on supporting evidence provided in the application form. Applications for unborn babies will not be considered.
  5. We can provide help in emergency situations from our Chair's Crisis Fund for Derby residents in immediate hardship or distress, for further information please contact the Trust on 01332 348155.
  6. Grants awarded for one or more of the items listed overleaf, are directly payable to our nominated supplier(s), Asda, Argos and Derby City Furniture (DCF). No cash grants are available. All approvals are on a fixed price basis – see overleaf for a detailed list.

For grants awarded through Asda, a cheque will be issued. The agent must come to the Liversage Trust office to collect the cheque. Grant completion paperwork and receipts must be returned to the Liversage Trust.

For grants awarded through Argos, payment will be by gift vouchers. Again, the agent must come to the Liversage Trust office to collect the vouchers. Grant completion paperwork and receipts must be returned to the Liversage Trust.

For grants awarded through DCF, items will be delivered to the applicant and the Trust will be invoiced directly. There is no need to return any paperwork for grants awarded through DCF.



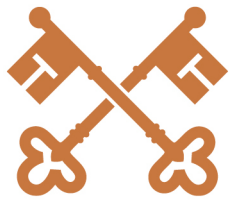
